New Fees Could Raise Price Of New Homes In Fresno

07/21/2007 - Fresno County Supervisors are considering new impact fees, and you could pay several thousand dollars more for the purchase of a new home.

If approved the increased impact fees would generate as much as an extra \$20 million a year.

The fees would help pay for county projects, like building new county offices or re-furbishing old buildings.

Henry Perea, Fresno County Supervisor, says "so between what we want to do, what other cities have already done, there has to be a balance. And that's why we're taking our time in doing it, that's why we're talking to other cities and people that will be involved, because ultimately it's the homebuyer that would pay the costs of these fees."

Over the next few months, the board will discuss how the fees would impact the people who live in Fresno County and what fee increases are appropriate.
