

Carroll commissioners poised to suspend collection of school impact fees

By deciding to temporarily stop charging developers a fee that helps pay for increased school capacity, the cost of building new homes will go down in Carroll County, according to Commissioner Robin Bartlett Frazier.

The Carroll County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing Thursday to discuss a proposal to lower the county's school capacity impact fee for all new residential development to zero. The fee will remain at zero for the next two years if the board approves the resolution on Aug. 21.
