## CITY COMMISSION HOLDING HEARING ON TRANSPORTATION IMPACT FEES

The Shelton City Commission is holding a public hearing on Transportation Impact fees tonight at six. The City hired Shea, Car & Jewel to complete a traffic study in the City and calculate an impact fee that will help offset the impact growth will have on transportation in the City. The proposed fee is \$1,610 per PM trip generated. Based on the traffic study, Perry Shea determined the City will need to complete over \$29.3 Million worth of transportation improvements in the next 20 years. In order to pay for and complete all those improvements, the City would have to charge an impact fee of over \$3,200 per trip. However, since the City currently doesn't have a transportation impact fee, Shea suggests starting with half that amount and phasing in yearly increases over the next six years to reach the maximum impact fee. Other items on the City Commission's draft agenda include action on the collective bargaining agreement with communications officers, a briefing on the Kneeland Park Pump Station phase of the Goldsborough Creek Sanitary Sewer project and an update on the Satellite Water Reclamation Plant project. The Shelton City Commission meets in the courtroom at the Civic Center, again at six tonight.
