



CRISFIELD NEWS: City to study impact fees

February 23, 2010

CRISFIELD — After suspending a \$5,000 impact fee for new construction two weeks ago, City Council members are scheduled to begin studying the issue further when they meet Wednesday.

Last year, the developer of a new Food Lion and four adjacent retail spaces was the only one to pay the fees. City officials will look at whether ending the fees will have a large impact on the budget.

Also on the agenda is a discussion of fees on subdivided lots outside city limits that receive water and sewer services.

The meeting is scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. at City Hall, 319 W. Main St. For information, call 410-968-1333.
