

Clay commission extends transportation impact fee moratorium

The Clay County Commission has extended a moratorium on collection of the county's transportation impact fee, which was scheduled to expire Dec. 31.

The commission approved an ordinance today that extends the moratorium through June 30, 2011.

Commissioners said they will revisit the fee after they know how the 2011 legislative session impacts the county budget.

Collection of the fee, which was intended to help pay for about \$450 million of continuing road improvements, was suspended Jan. 1, 2009, to help the struggling Clay construction industry.

The moratorium does not affect the school district's educational impact fee of \$7,034 on new residential projects. That fee remains in effect.
