## **Dorchester County to vote on fees**

DORCHESTER COUNTY, S.C. - It could be a council heated meeting Monday night in St. George.

The controversial transportation impact fee is up for a final vote after months of debate.

The proposal would essentially charge some home builders in the county a fee. That money would then be used to transportation projects.

The amount of the fee would be dependent on the amount of traffic around each home building project.

Some council members are reportedly considering voting yes, only so they can later appeal the passage.

A 'yes' vote is required in order to appeal.

The meeting starts at 7pm inside council chambers on Johnson Street.
