Pasco agrees to cut impact fees

Commissioner Henry Wilson explained he would support cutting impact fees under one condition: "My request is to you, if we are reducing these fees, is that you reduce the fees that are to the people who are buying the houses."

In the end, commissioners agreed to cut impact fees by up to half. They will finalize the new fee schedule within a month.
