## Tehama County Impact Fee workshop today

Tehama County will hold its first workshop on Development Impact Fees today at 6 p.m. at the B

The workshop marks the beginning of a process expected to take months, Planning Director Gec morning.

If implemented, new fees could apply to new county construction to pay for libraries, roads, law e

The board previously approved a Nexus study linking fees to improved county infrastructure, thoi maximum buildout, a figure which reflects the maximum population growth Tehama County coul from the county's General Plan.

The fees in the Nexus study, including \$14,000 on a new, single-family residence, are not realisti option of scaling those fees back to reflect a more likely population growth.

The fees may also overlap with pending air mitigation fees, a separate strategy the Tehama Cou way to fund air cleanup efforts.
