# City Commission to discuss impact fees, selling ad space on city property

Bozeman officials will discuss city impact fee policies during the Monday meeting of the Bozeman City Commission.

The fees charge new developments for impacts to city infrastructure, such as the water supply or fire department. Commissioners will talk about why Bozeman charges them, the pros and cons, and other options the city has for maintaining the same level of service. Staff have recently received letters asking for a re-examination of street impact fees. Both the Southwest Montana Building Industry Association and the Gallatin Association of Realtors say those fees are too high.

The commission will also consider selling advertising space on city property, including the downtown parking garage and Streamline Bus shelters.

The weekly public meeting kicks off at 6 p.m. at City Hall.
