

Hamilton Twp. trustees creating an impact fee committee, seek participants

The Hamilton Twp. trustees are starting an Impact Fee Advisory Committee and seeking residents willing to join.

Community Development Director Gary Boeres said the purpose of a committee would be to review proposed improvement projects for township roads and parks as well as police and fire departments. The committee will then pass suggestions to the board of trustees, which makes the final decision.

Along with two township residents, the committee

will also have a representative from the Home Builders Association, the Ohio Valley Developers Association

and a technical expert — such as an engineer or

architect.

"This committee will be thinking about long-term solutions to issues facing our growing community," Trustee Michael Muñoz said. "The recommending body will provide valuable information to the board."

The committee will meet quarterly.
